Conduct Expectations for Extracurricular & Co-Curricular Activities

Participation in extra-curricular/co-curricular activities is a privilege, not a right. Each sponsor or coach, along with the principal, shall have the authority to establish specific guidelines for membership and leadership eligibility. Because of the demands and responsibilities of membership on teams or squads, elected offices, appointed positions, and varied activities in organizations, participants must be able to commit time and effort while maintaining the highest of standards while representing Frenship ISD. Participants agree to comply with the behavioral guidelines set forth in the 2016-17 Frenship ISD Code of Conduct, the campus handbook, and the Code of Conduct for Extra-curricular/Co-curricular Activities. The participant understands that this code shall govern not only conduct at school and school-sponsored activities, but also conduct at any time outside the school day. The participant is also aware that if he/she violates the Code of Conduct, they may lose the privilege of participation.

Participants are accountable for all guidelines in the Frenship ISD Student Code of Conduct, with particular emphasis on the following sections:

Disciplinary actions for incidents occurring during extra-curricular/co-curricular programs:

Minor offenses – The participant will be disciplined at the discretion of the sponsor or coach.

Serious misbehavior offenses – The participant will be disciplined by the campus administration according to campus and district policies. Also, the first serious offense will result in probation for extra-curricular activities or possible suspension from extra-curricular. A second serious offense will result in suspension from extra-curricular/co-curricular programs and activities. The participant will also be disciplined at the discretion of the sponsor or coach.

I understand and consent to the responsibilities outlined above and in the Frenship ISD Student Code of Conduct and the campus handbook. I also understand and agree that I shall be held accountable for the behavior and consequences outlined above for any school related misconduct, regardless of time and location. I understand that any violation of campus and district policies will be subject to disciplinary action which could result in my losing the privilege of participating in extracurricular/co-curricular programs.

**PARENT/STUDENT UIL MARCHING BAND
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM**

No student may be required to attend practice for marching band for more than eight hours of rehearsal outside the academic school day per calendar week (Sunday through Saturday). This provision applies to students in all components of the marching band.

On performance days (football games, competitions and other public performances) bands may hold up to one additional hour of warm-up and practice beyond the scheduled warm-up time at the performance site. Multiple performances on the same day do not allow for additional practice and/or warm-up time.

Examples Of Activities Subject To The UIL Marching Band Eight Hour Rule.

- Marching Band Rehearsal (Both Full Band And Components)
- Any Marching Band Group Instructional Activity
- Breaks
- Announcements
- Debriefing And Viewing Marching Band Videos
- Playing Off Marching Band Music
- Marching Band Sectionals (Both Director And Student Led)
- Clinics For The Marching Band Or Any Of Its Components

The Following Activities Are Not Included In The Eight Hour Time Allotment:

- Travel Time To And From Rehearsals And/Or Performances
- Rehearsal Set-Up Time
- Pep Rallies, Parades And Other Public Performances
- Instruction And Practice For Music Activities Other Than Marching Band And Its Components
